All businesses have a duty of care to staff, visitors and contractors who enter their building. Installing an Evacuation Chair and individuals trained to use it, ensures that those who would normally use an elevator to enter or exit a building, have an adequate means of escape in a fire emergency.

The Evacuation Chair is designed to help those in charge with the evacuation of non ambulant persons from their building in the event of an emergency. It is not 'reasonable' to leave anyone in a refuge area on an upper floor, while the building is on fire.
