



TQUK Level 3 Award in First Aid at Work with Level 2 AED Bolt-on (RQF)

It takes 18 hours to complete this 3 day course including the assessments. Unit 1 highlights the basic principles of first aid, whereas Unit 2 looks at complex medical emergencies. The bolt-on trains and assesses learners in the use of AEDs for an extra qualification.

Unit 1 - Our students will be able to:

- Understand the role and responsibilities of a first aider and assess an incident
- Manage an unresponsive casualty who is breathing normally
- Manage an unresponsive casualty who is not breathing normally
- · Recognise and assist a casualty who is choking
- Manage a casualty with external bleeding
- Manage a casualty who is in shock
- Manage a casualty with minor injury for choking, external bleeding, shock and minor injuries

Unit 2 - Our students will be able to administer first aid to a casualty with:

- Injuries to bones, muscles and joints
- Suspected head and spinal injuries
- Suspected chest injuries
- Burns and scalds
- An eye injury
- Sudden poisoning
- Anaphylaxis

Level 2 AED Bolt-on: our students will learn about:

- Heart conditions and sudden cardiac arrest
- Basic Life Support (including CPR training)
- Resuscitation Council (UK) guidelines (and any updates they have made)
- AEDs what they do, how they do it, and how to use them
